## Who is Eligible

**Qualify for a \$0 desktop computer, mobile hotspot, and one year internet service, if you:**

- Receive SNAP, Medicaid, SSI Federal Public Housing Assistance, Veterans Pension Benefit Program, **Or** have a household income that is less than 135% of federal poverty guidelines (*for example, below \$35,000 per year for a family of 4*)
- **And** have an existing Indeed account, or willing to create one at time of pickup
- **And** are enrolled, or recently completed, a workforce training and development program

**Qualify for a \$0 desktop computer or \$20 laptop, if you:**

- Receive SNAP, Medicaid, SSI Federal Public Housing Assistance, Veterans Pension Benefit Program, **Or** have a household income that is less than 135% of federal poverty guidelines (*for example, below \$35,000 per year for a family of 4*)
